Thank you for making such a long drive from home to meet with me recently. All of us in the Duke University School of Medicine thank you for your generous estate commitment to establish the Karen Paddock Memorial Fund in the Division of Neuroradiology in memory of your wife.

As we discussed, I have taken specific steps to ensure that our medical students learn about cerebrospinal fluid leak as a cause of positional headache. We will develop materials for medical students during their neurobiology course which will include reading Mrs. Paddock's online blog, and we will also prepare case studies on this subject for the neurology rotation. I believe that these measures together with research will advance physicians' understanding of Intracranial Hypo-Hypertension, which will lead to better diagnosis and treatment of the condition.
